
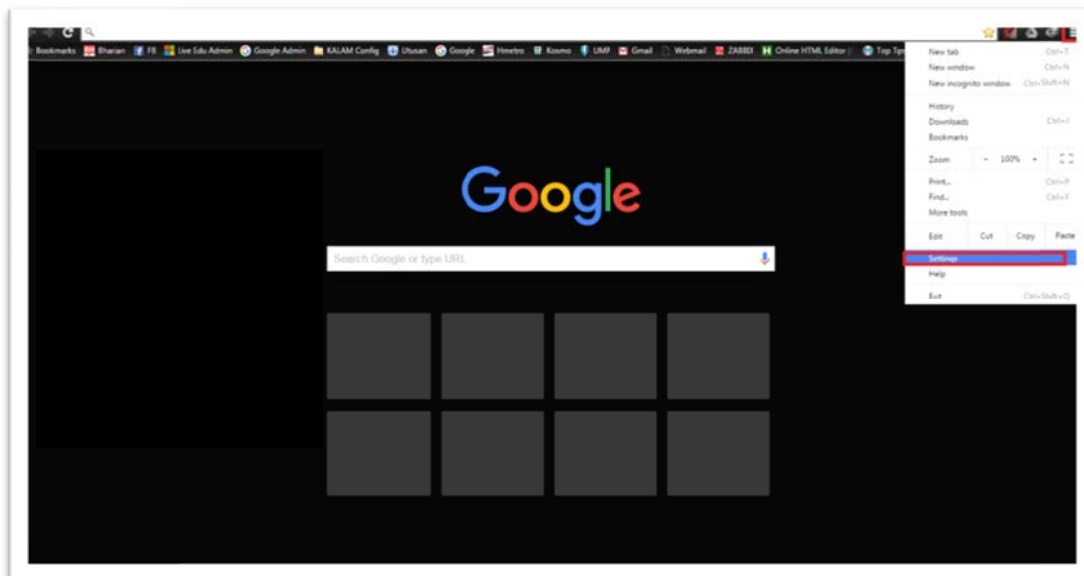


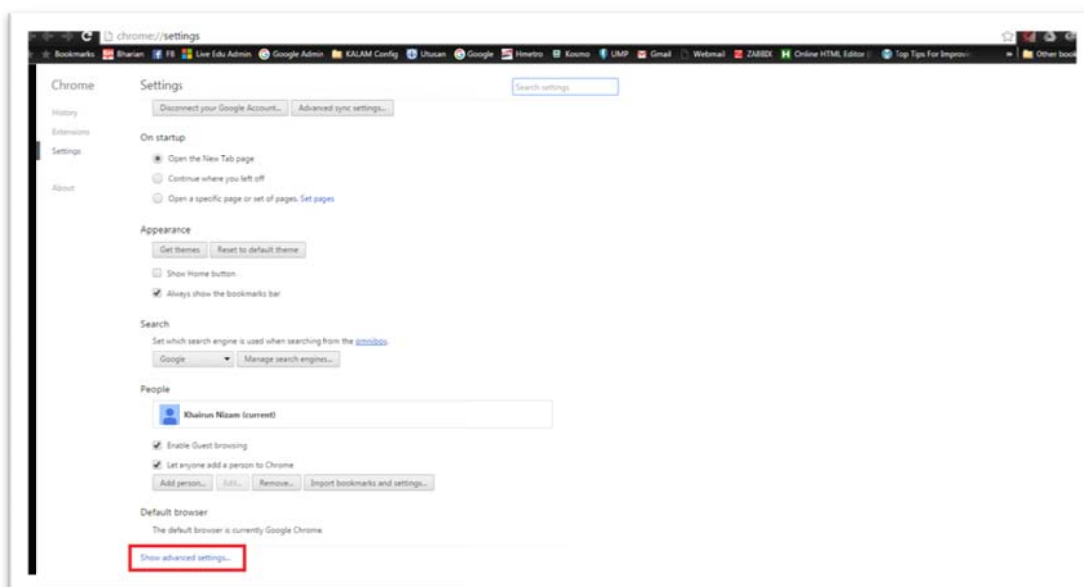
## HOW TO CONFIGURE PROXY SETTING IN YOUR BROWSER

### 1. Google Chrome web browser

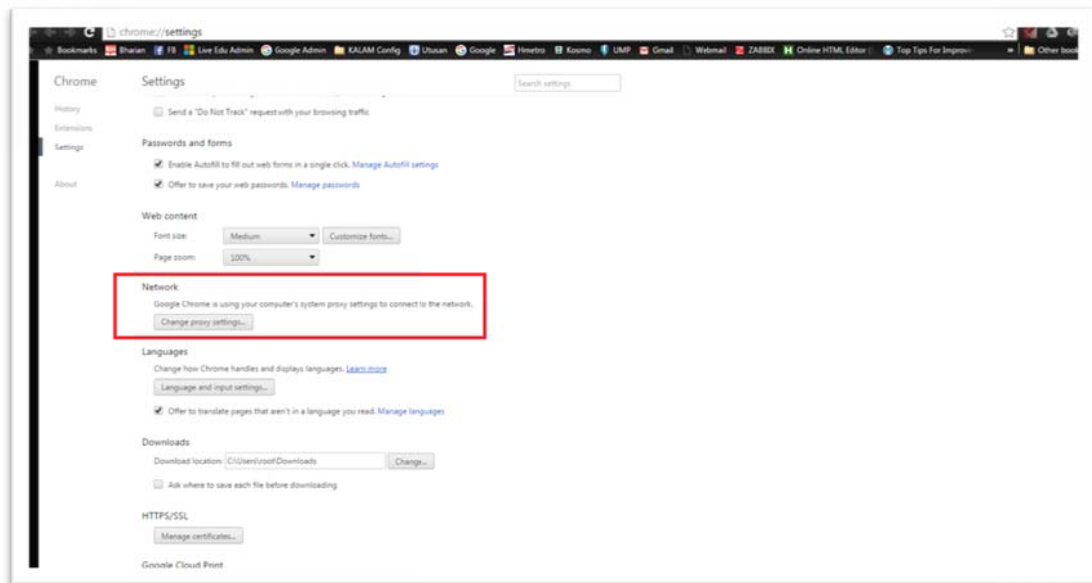
- a. Please click Google Chrome customization icon  at the top menu. Then, please select **Settings** menu. Please refer the red box from the below image.

- c. Select **Network** item and click at the Change Proxy Settings



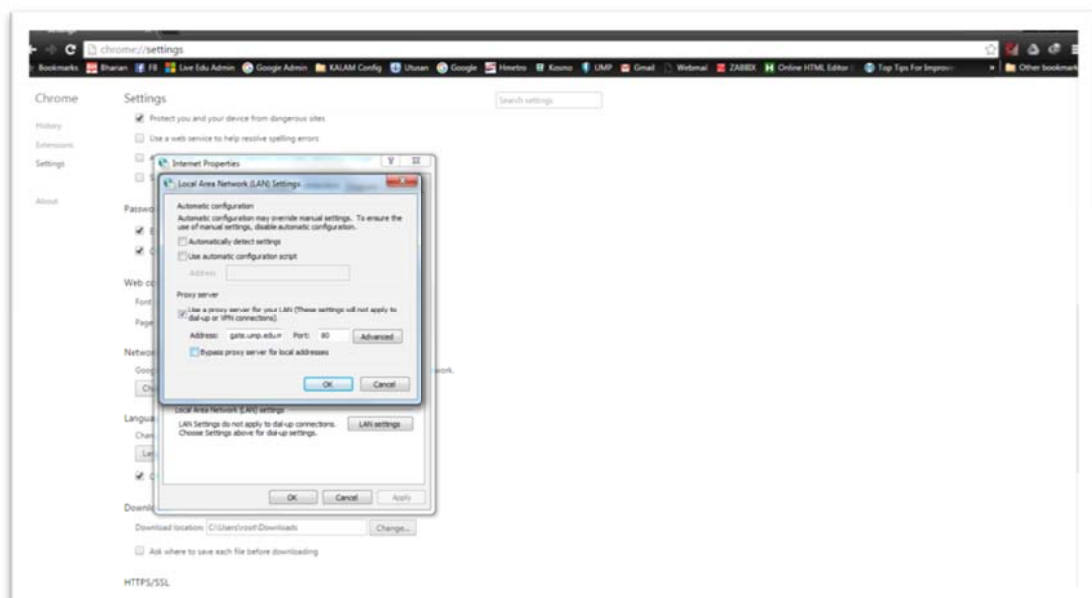
- d. Please fill in this information at the **Address** and **Port** column

Address: **gate.ump.edu.my**

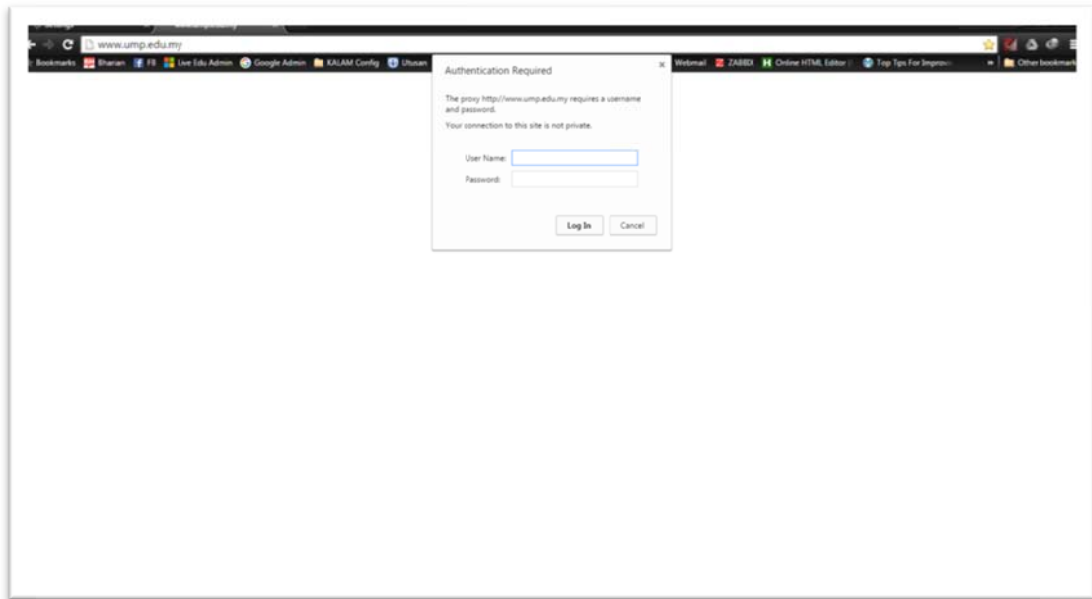

Click **OK** to finish.



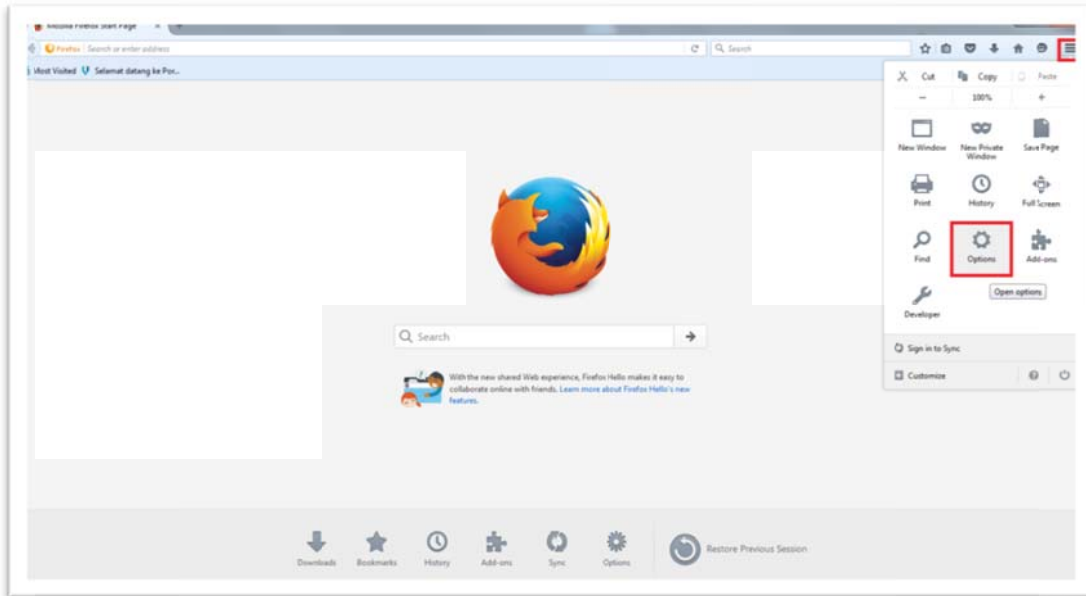


- e. You can start browsing now. For first time, you will be prompt for username and password. Please use your E-Community Username & Password to login

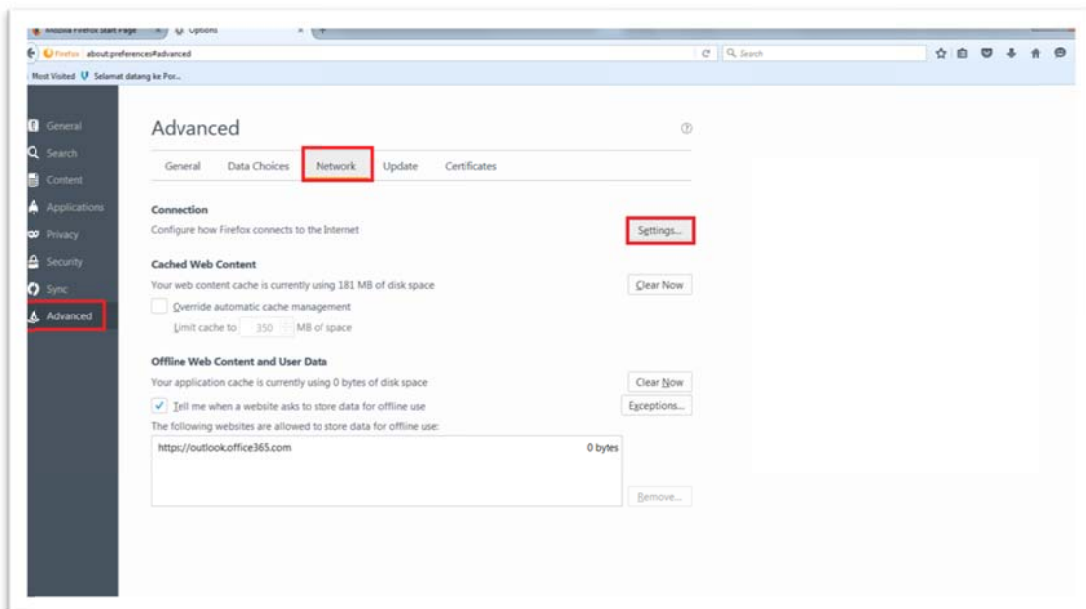


## 2. Mozilla Firefox web browser

- a. Select menu icon  from top right menu and then click at **Options** menu. Please refer image below

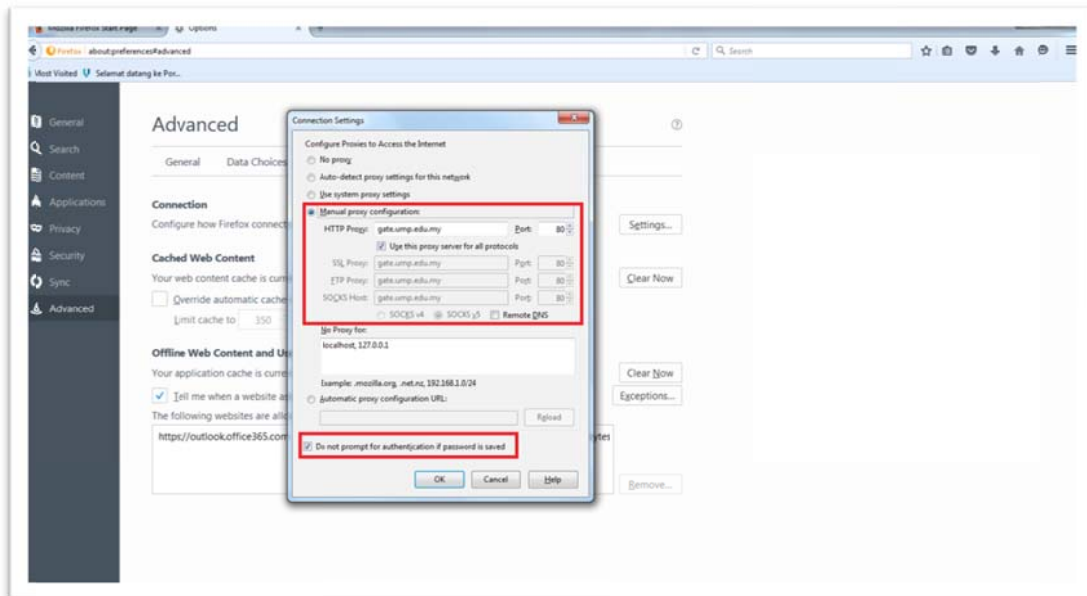


- b. Select **Advanced** -> **Network** and click at the **Settings** menu
